



CPBA Travel All Star Selection Acknowledgement Form

The CPBA PONY Sanctioned Travel All Star teams have an opportunity to play against teams from other cities. The managers from your team’s division will be selecting these players. In exchange for this opportunity, CPBA requires a commitment from the players and their families to the All Star team. The players are expected to attend all practices and tournament games. The All Star season will begin with practices and pre-PONY sanctioned tournaments beginning approximately May 15th. PONY sanctioned tournaments begin on or about June 17th, and will continue throughout July and possibly into August depending on how well the team does. **All players must have this form completed and returned to their manager or camponybaseball@outlook.com NO LATER THAN 5/3/17 in order to be eligible for all-star selection draft. Managers must have completed form at the all-star selection draft for player to be considered. No exceptions.**

- The fee for All Stars is \$100 per player, payable to CPBA. **All players must pay this fee before the team will receive their uniforms and be registered in the tournaments.**
- CPBA will pay tournament entry fees for the team’s **first round only** of PONY Sanctioned tournament play.
- It is also important that you know additional fees may be incurred by each player.
 - Some PONY tournament hosts will charge a fee each day at the gate and some who are unable to do so will charge a fee up front per team. This fee is the responsibility of each player or team.
 - Hotel accommodations, if necessary, are the responsibility of each player/team.
- **ALL PARENTS of All Star players will be required to volunteer at some level, whether it is scorekeeping during PONY Sanctioned Tournaments, Snack bar duties, or Field Maintenance. This is a required 6 hour shift. _____ please initial**

Since the team is representing Camarillo, the manager will be fielding the team which he believes gives Camarillo the best opportunity to win. This may mean that some players will not play in some games. While all the players are All Star caliber, certain situations will dictate that certain players are on the field; there are no minimum playing time rules. In the past, managers have tried to ensure that everyone played. **However, playing time is at the manager’s discretion. _____ please initial**
